Stallion Indemnity Form

- All stallions must display a yellow ribbon in their tail during an EETO event.
- All riders (members and day-members) and their parent in the case of Young Gun and Youth riders are responsible for their horses and their horses behavior at all times.
- A new indemnity form must be completed for each EETO event.
- Should a Young Gun / Youth rider decide to ride a stallion the total responsibility regarding safety of the other rides in contact with that stallion will be with the rider and his / her parents/guardian.
- A Young Gun / Youth rider may only compete on a stallion if they have submitted the stallion indemnity form via email to extremetrailsa@gmail.com
- The organisers of EETO reserve the right to intervene at any stage should they feel that the stallion and / or rider poses a safety risk to themselves or anyone else present.
- EETO and participating landowners may not be held liable for any losses, damages or injuries sustained by horses, riders, officials, the public or their property.
